Re: Freedom of Information Request FOI 4258

We are writing in response to your request submitted under the Freedom of Information Act, received in this office on 19th February 2020.

Your request was as follows:

This is in relation to use of Anti Infectives within your Organisation:

1 - How many patients have you treated in the last 12 months for complicated Intra Abdominal Infections with the following:

Amoxicillin/clauvanate

Piperacillin/tazobactam

Ceftazidime/avibactam (Zavicefta)

Ceftolozane/tazobactam (Zerbaxa)

Carbapenems (such as: Meropenem, Imipenem/cilastatin, Ertapenem)

Aminoglycosides (such as: Gentamicin, Amikacin, Tobramycin)

Cephalosporins (such as: Cefotaxime, Ceftazidime, Ceftriaxone)

Quinolones (such as: Ciprofloxacin, Levofloxacin, Ofloxacin)

Polymixins (such as: Colistin)

We do not collate antibiotics usage by indication/ condition therefore we cannot provide this. We also cannot provide how many patients were treated with the list of drugs stated as antibiotics are kept as stock in ward areas so this would not be accurate.
