We are writing in response to your request submitted under the Freedom of Information Act, received in this office on 02nd June 2020.

Your request was as follows:

1: How many sharps containers were disposed of annually for your NHS Hospital Trust within the last 10 years?

The Trust implemented a new sharps system approximately 7 years ago which resulted in NO sharps containers being disposed of. I do not have the information for the 3 years prior to that.

2: What is the annual recorded cost for sharps container disposal for your NHS Hospital Trust within the last 10 years?

As per above as we haven't disposed of any sharps containers in the past 7 years this data is not available. I do not have the information for the 3 years prior to that.
