## Re: Freedom of Information Request FOI 5516

We are writing in response to your request submitted under the Freedom of Information Act, received in this office on 05th January 2023.

Your request was as follows:

I am looking for some assistance with your organisation's Spend/Transparency data, available on the following weblink:

There appears to be no file available for the month of October 2022. Could you advise when the file will be made available to view online? Would it be possible for you to email me a copy of the October 2022 file please & Thank you.

I can confirm that The Walton Centre NHS Foundation Trust holds the information you have requested. However, I am unable to provide you with that information as I consider that the following exemptions apply to it:

Section 22 - Information is intended for future publication:

The information you have requested is exempt from disclosure under Section 22(1) of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). There is a clear intention to publish the information at a future date and in line with section 22(1)(c) it is considered reasonable in all the circumstances that the information should be withheld from disclosure until the date of publication. The delay for the October and November data has been caused by staff shortages in the Finance department.

As a result, we believe that the information is intended for future publication and will be made accessible to you.

## Public Interest Test:

To use this exception we are required to undertake a public interest test. The matters which were considered in applying the public interest test are as follows:

Factors in favour of disclosure:

• Disclosure of the information supports the general public interest in the transparency, accountability and general understanding of the delivery of public services.

Factors in favour of withholding:









• Withholding the information allows for the correct procedural sign off before public publication.

This response therefore acts as a refusal notice under section 17 of the FolA.
