We are writing in response to your request submitted under the Freedom of Information Act, received in this office on 15th May 2023.

Your request was as follows:

Please may you provide me with:

Confirmation if the trust works under, Non-Clinical Temporary and Fixed Term Staff CCS Framework RM6160 and the new CCS Non-Clinical Staffing Framework Agreement RM6277.

If the trust works under, these frameworks, please can you provide a list of agencies that have supplied you with non-clinical staff and a breakdown of agency spend by bands between May 2022 and April 2023.

Can you also please provide the contact details of the person/persons responsible for agreeing non-clinical staffing call-off contracts, for roles which would fall under Lot 2 (Corporate Functions) and Lot 6 (Estates, Facilities Management & Ancillary Staff).

Lastly please can you provide organisational charts with names and jobs titles for the Estates, Facilities Management and Corporate Functions departments.

I can confirm that the Walton Centre NHS Foundation Trust work under the RM6160 framework.

The Trust had an Interim Director of Nursing and Governance provided by the agency Finegreen with a spend of £4038.35.

The Workforce Procurement Team are responsible for non-clinical staff - The Walton Centre NHS Foundation Trust does not disclose individual staff members contact details. You can write to staff using the address above or alternatively email wcft.enquiries@nhs.net asking for your correspondence to be forwarded on.

I confirm that The Walton Centre NHS Foundation Trust (WCFT) holds the information you have requested for the organisational chart. However, I am unable to provide you with that information as I consider that the following exemptions apply to it.
